- I. Tour of YWCA Oahu – Fernhurst
 - a. The Commission has found it necessary to complete an on-site inspection at Fernhurst Residence as one of the Commission’s purposes and functions is to research and understand how to shift from a punitive to a rehabilitative corrections system, in accordance with HB 1552 Act 179.
 - b. This on-site inspection is pivotal to the Commission’s work as Fernhurst is entirely mission oriented and dedicated to empowering women successfully transitioning from prison back into the community. Public attendance is not practicable as there is limited space.
