*restrictive housing for members of vulnerable populations by 1/8/2027. Requires the Hawai'i Correctional System Oversight Commission to review restrictive housing placements on an annual basis. Authorizes the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, by 12/1/2027, to implement policies and procedures recommended by the restrictive housing working group related to committed persons. Requires interim and final reports to the Legislature and Hawai'i Correctional System Oversight Commission. (CD1)*
